Building Permits Required and Fee Schedule

New Single Family Homes

A. Up to 2500 total sq. ft.	\$585.00
B. From 2500 sq. ft. to 3499 sq. ft.	\$675.00
C. From 3500 sq. ft. and up	\$775.00

Multi-Family Homes

A. Duplex	\$800.00
B. Multi-Family Per Unit	\$400.00

Commercial Buildings and Garage

- A. Commercial Building and Additions-Minimum is \$300.00 OR is \$.10 per sq. ft. OR \$10.00 per \$1,000.00 of Construction Costs, depending on scope of construction
- B. Barns, Sheds, and Garages (including Residential) up to 1,000 sq. ft. \$125.00 OR Over 1,000 sq. ft. \$175.00

Dwelling Alteration/Decks/Remodel, depending on scope of construction	\$200.00-\$500.00
Dwelling Addition	\$250.00
Mobile/Manufactured Homes	\$300.00/unit
Electrical, HVAC & Plumbing (Repair/Replacement)	\$ 75.00
Moving Building	50.00 per \$20,000.00 cost of building
Fences, Pools, Hot Tubs, Signs, Sheds, Siding, Porches, etc.	\$ 40.00
Gazebos, Awnings, Canopies, Window & Exterior Door Size Changes, etc.	\$ 40.00
Driveway (DMO enforced)	\$ 40.00
Re-inspection Fee	\$ 50.00/each
Inspections Not Related to Permits	\$ 50.00/time
Building Without A Village Permit	Double Fees
No permit is required for roofing.	

NOTES:

1. Section 14.08 of the Village Municipal Code requires that the applicant obtain and pay for all building permits prior to the actual start of proposed work.
2. Each permit applicant will be issued a copy of this fee schedule. The applicant agrees to complete the work described on his/her building permit in compliance with all applicable codes/zoning ordinances, state statues, local, federal and state building code requirements and with the conditions of the permit obtained from the Village.
3. Fences and swimming pools must meet the requirement of Section 14.13 of the Village Building Code.

Important Points to remember for New Dwelling Construction:

All work must be performed by licensed trades, pursuant to requirements of the State of Wisconsin Uniform Dwelling Code.

The dwelling cannot be occupied until a final inspection for occupancy has been completed to ensure that provisions of the State Building Code have been met.

The State Building Code requires a 48 hours Inspection notice. This notice excludes Saturdays, Sundays and Holidays.
