UNFINISHED BUSINESS:

H1: Wussow talked with the land surveyor and everything is okay for the Village to approve the Certified Survey Map No. 2517. Barney introduced Resolution 2016-16 Certified Survey Map No. 2517. Second by Luepke. Roll call vote was taken. Motion carried unanimously.

NEW BUSINESS:
