## VILLAGE OF BONDUEL/TOWN OF HARTLAND FIRE COMMISSION MEETING MAY 19, 2022

<u>APPROVAL OF AGENDA</u>: Motion by Simon, second by Genke, to approve the agenda and to deviate from the order as necessary. Motion carried unanimously.

<u>APPROVAL OF MINUTES:</u> Motion by Simon, second by Gehm, to approve the Fire Commission minutes from April 21, 2022 meeting as presented. Motion carried unanimously.

## **REPORTS**

<u>FIRE CHIEF'S REPORT:</u> Report on file. Chief Woldt reported that a nozzle broke which will cost between \$699 to \$800 to replace.

<u>OUTSTANDING FIRE BILLS:</u> Report on file of outstanding fire bills. Commission reviewed report.

## **NEW BUSINESS**

- <u>G1. Discussion and possible action on DNR Grant.</u> The DNR grant is a 50% match grant. The Village and Hartland would be responsible for half of the bill which would be approximately \$1,075. The money would be used to purchase wildland fire helmets. No motion made.
- <u>G2. Discussion and possible action on missing fire numbers in Hartland.</u> In the township there are some missing fire numbers that need to replaced. In addition, it was questioned how the department can get into properties with driveways that have locked gates if there is a fire. No motion made.
- <u>G3. Discussion and possible action on Fire Department Officers.</u> Elections were held at the last Fire Department meeting. Robbie Woldt, Fire Chief; Doug Harland, Secretary; Kevin Lynch, Assistant Chief; Robbie Woldt III and Justin Shatters, Lieutenants. Chief Woldt will provide a complete list at the next meeting.
- G4. Discussion and review of Bonduel Municipal Code Sec. 2-83, Ethical Standards and Regulations. The Village ethical standards and regulations are reviewed each year. The Commission reviewed the ordinance and did not have any questions.
- <u>G4. Closed Session.</u> Motion by Gehm, second by Genke, to move to session for approximately five minutes, to review firefighter application and member participation. [Pursuant to Wis. Motion carried unanimously. Commission moved into closed session at 5:50 p.m.
