

**VILLAGE OF BONDUEL/TOWN OF HARTLAND  
FIRE COMMISSION MEETING  
JUNE 16, 2022**

Chairperson Randy Radloff called the meeting to order at 5:30 p.m. and read the statement regarding the meeting notice.

PRESENT: Randy Radloff, Jeff Simon, Bill Lee, Randy Genke, and Tom Riehl. Absent: Russ Gehm. Also, in attendance Chief Robbie Woldt.

APPROVAL OF AGENDA: Motion by Simon, second by Lee, to approve the agenda and to deviate from the order as necessary. Motion carried unanimously.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES: Motion by Lee, second by Genke, to approve the Fire Commission minutes from May 19, 2022 meeting as presented. Motion carried unanimously.

REPORTS

FIRE CHIEF'S REPORT: Report on file. Department is looking at purchasing a new laptop computer to run a new fire simulator program on that was donated to the department. The program is valued at \$1,500.

OUTSTANDING FIRE BILLS: Report on file of outstanding fire bills. Commission reviewed report.

NEW BUSINESS

G1. Discussion and possible action on access to chained or gated properties. The department has and/or will make contact with these businesses about obtaining access to these properties. By consensus the Commission agreed to remove the agenda item and have personnel get in contact with land owners.

G2. Discussion and possible action on Fourth of July participation. Participation for the Fourth of July was discussed. Woldt is having problem getting help to direct traffic during the parade. Woldt will continue to look for help but at this point there is no one signed up to help for traffic control.

G3. Discussion and possible action on radio replacement. The department needs to order a new portable radio, the cost will be \$2,300. This cost was already budgeted for in the 2022 Budget. By consensus the Commission agreed to remove the agenda item and order the radio.

G4. Discussion on Training Facility. Chief Woldt updated the Commission on the Training Facility. The facility is up and running.

H1. Discussion and possible action on missing fire number in Hartland. The Town of Hartland has ordered new signs and will be putting them up once the signs are received.

H2. Discussion and possible action on approval of Fire Department Officers. The 2022-2023 Fire Department Officers are Robbie Woldt, Fire Chief; Kevin Lynch, Assistant Chief; Chris Gehm, Captain; Robbie Woldt III, 1<sup>st</sup> Lieutenant; Justin Shatters, 2<sup>nd</sup> Lieutenant; and Brad Hoeffs, Safety Officer. By consensus the Commission approved the appointment of the 2022-2023 Fire Department Officers.
