

Village of Bonduel  
Municipal Operations Committee  
July 28, 2020

Chairperson Barb Wickman called the meeting to order at 6:03 p.m. Present were Kay Hottenstine and Renell Bartlett. Also present was Jesse Rankin, Director of Municipal Operation. The statement regarding the meeting was read.

Bartlett made a motion to approve the agenda as presented. Hottenstine seconded. Motion carried.

Bartlett made a motion to approve the minutes from the June 23, 2020 meeting. Hottenstine seconded. Motion carried.

The committee reviewed the 2019 Financial report.

Discussion was held on the Highway 117/Cecil Street project. This committee needs to have a recommendation to the board and then to the WI DOT. The DOT has in their plans to add sidewalk on the east side of Cecil Street to Grant Street. Discussion was held on having sidewalk to South Street. The committee discussed the two alternatives presented by the DOT. Alternative #1 is to have two lanes of traffic with a bicycle lane on each side of the street. Alternative #2 is to leave the street with the turn lane in the middle as it is now. The committee felt that alternative #2 with the turn lane is the best option. The committee would like Jesse to check on the possibility to have sidewalk to Express Way. The committee discussed the parking on North Cecil and the recommendation would be to keep the parallel parking. Wickman made a motion that we recommend to the board to stay with Alternative #2 with center turn lane, to check on sidewalk through Express Way, and to keep the parallel parking on North Cecil Street. Bartlett seconded. Motion carried.

Discussion was held on the 20-year plan. It was decided that we Look at doing Ganschow, Express Way, 117/N Cecil Street parking lanes and sidewalk on South Cecil Street. Jesse will check with engineers as to the viability of the project, to Ehlers as to the borrowing and to the auditors for what we can use for cash on hand in the water utility. Item is postponed to next Municipal Operations meeting.

Ehlers is still working on the analysis of the water utility for a rate increase. Postpone to next Municipal Operations Committee meeting.

DMO report was presented.

Bartlett made a motion to adjourn. Hottenstine seconded. Meeting adjourned at 8:00 p.m.
