

Village of Bonduel
Municipal Operations Committee
October 27, 2020

The meeting was called to order by Chairperson Barb Wickman at 6:00 p.m. Present were Kay Hottenstine and Renell Bartlett. Also present were Jesse Rankin, Director of Municipal Operations and Kevin Wagner from Rueckert Mielke.

A statement regarding the posting of the meeting was read.

Hottenstine made a motion to approve the agenda and to deviate from the order as necessary. Bartlett seconded. Motion carried.

Bartlett made a motion to approve the minutes from September 22, 2020. Hottenstine seconded. Motion carried.

Discussion was held on the road work timeline. Kevin Wagner from Rueckert Mielke presented the projects and when we would be looking at bidding and doing the projects. By consensus this item can be removed from the agenda.

Discussion was held on the parking situation at the Village Hall. Jesse suggested a possibility of doing angle parking on east side and make First Street one way until State Street. This would create eight spots. Jesse will put some numbers together and possible place as a second alternate on the contract for streets. Wickman made a motion to have Jesse put some numbers together for angle parking and one-way street on North First by Village Hall and report back to next meeting. Bartlett seconded. Motion carried.

Discussion was held on reducing the speed limit to 25 mph on Green Bay Street. The county will require to have a speed study done on Green Bay Street. Jesse prepared a letter to send the request to the County. Bartlett made a motion to recommend to the board that we reduce the speed on Green Bay Street to 25 mph contingent on finding out the costs for the speed study and any other contingencies. Hottenstine seconded. Motion carried.

Discussion was held on the official traffic map. By consensus we will wait to hear from Kevin Wagner to see if Rueckert Mielke has a copy of the map that was done several years ago.

Discussion was held on purchasing property located at Green Bay Street and Washington Street. United Coop has asked if the village would be interested in purchasing this property. The price is less than \$20,000. The property is assessed at \$18,000. Bartlett motion to recommend to the board to not purchase the property located at Green Bay and Washington Street. Hottenstine seconded. Motion carried.

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Discussion was held on a recommendation to move the village hall. Discussion was held on options for the village hall and the committee asked Jesse to continue to report back to the committee. By consensus Jesse will continue to pursue options.

Discussion was held on hiring of a part time custodian. Bartlett made a motion to combine items seven and eight. Hottenstine seconded. Motion carried.

Bartlett made a motion to recommend to the board to hire a person for custodian and/or recycling site and to post on Village website and Facebook. Hottenstine seconded. Motion carried.

DMO report. Water main break at Mill and First Street. Lost approximately 100,000 gallons of water so it was fixed pretty rapidly. Well #3 rehab that is being done, was pulled today. Should have back on line in a week. Leaf pick is done every day.

Bartlett made a motion to adjourn. Hottenstine seconded. Adjourned at 7:44 p.m.
