

VILLAGE OF BONDUEL  
MUNICIPAL OPERATIONS MEETING  
TUESDAY, APRIL 26, 2022

NEW BUSINESS

**F1. Discussion and possible recommendation on park waiver fees for the American Legion**

Motion by Hottenstine, second by Paige, to recommend to the Village Board that the park fee be waived for the American Legion. Motion carried.

**F2: Discussion and possible recommendation on stop sign at the intersection of North Street and Flambeau Road.**

Director Rankin was approached by a resident about the safety of the intersection at Flambeau Road, North Street, Depot Street and the exit of Lumberyard Bar & Grill and requested that a four-way stop be installed. Director Rankin discussed this with Chief Krause and it was agreed that it would be a good idea.

Motion by Hottenstine, second by Paige, to recommend to the Village Board to have a four way stop sign put up at the intersection of Flambeau Road, North Street, Depot Street and the exit of Lumberyard Bar & Grill. Motion carried.

**F3: Discussion and possible recommendation on Bonduel Municipal Code Sec. 22-8, Littering**

Motion by Hottenstine, second by Court, to invite the Amish community to the next village board meeting to discuss the cleanup of horse manure in regards to the Bonduel Municipal Code Sec. 22-8, Littering. Motion carried.

**F4: 4. Discussion on playground equipment design.**

Motion by Court, second by Paige, to present to the Village Board two options for playground equipment and to post the two options on Facebook to get the public's opinion about which option is preferred. Motion carried.

Director Rankin discussed the DMO report that was included with the Committee packet.

Motion by Court, second by Hottenstine, to adjourn at 5:17 p.m. Motion carried.
