Chairperson Sharon Wussow called the meeting to order 4:02 p.m. Present was Renell Bartlett. Also present were Police Chief, Tony Escalante; Interim Building Inspector, Paul Hahn and President Elect, Russ Gehm.

Agenda: Motion by Bartlett, second by Wussow to approve the agenda and to deviate from the order as necessary. Motion carried unanimously.

Minutes: Motion by Wussow, second by Bartlett, to approve the minutes from March 25, 2019 meeting as presented. Motion carried unanimously.

G1. Building Inspector Error & Omissions Insurance: Paul Hahn has not gotten information on insurance yet. Clerk Maroszek is checking with Mc Clone agency to see if Hahn can obtain insurance through them for Errors & Omissions insurance. Postpone until the next meeting.

H1. Building Permit Fee Schedule: Motion by Wussow, second by Bartlett, to recommend to the Board the changes to the building permit fee schedule. Motion carried unanimously.

H2. County Ordinances: Motion by Wussow, second by Bartlett, to recommend to the Board the addition of the County Ordinance to Village Ordinance in regards to purchase, possession and use of Nicotine by minors, having Maroszek forward to the Village Attorney to get correct location in village ordinance book. Motion carried unanimously.

H3. Adopt current NFPA standards for Village Ordinance: Motion by Bartlett, second by Wussow, to recommend to the Board the adoption of the current NFPA standards for Village Ordinances. Motion carried unanimously.

H4. Ordinance Sec. 22.21(g) sex offender residency restrictions: Motion by Wussow, second by Bartlett, to recommend to the Board Sec. 22-21(g) change and also to change to Village Board Sex Offender Residence Appeal Form. In addition, put into the Fee Schedule cost of meeting and administrative costs for the appeal process, using supplied special board meeting protocol.

H5. Chicken Ordinance: Motion by Wussow, second by Bartlett, to recommend to the board to add Shawano information to the Bonduel Ordinance, giving to the Village Attorney to okay the location. Also, change the back page and get an application for a coop permit from Shawano. Motion carried unanimously.

H6. Revocation of operators' license procedure: By consensus move to the next meeting to clarify points explanation.

Motion by Bartlett, second by Wussow to adjourn. Meeting adjourned at 7:14 p.m.
