

VILLAGE OF BONDUEL  
PUBLIC SAFETY COMMITTEE MEETING  
MONDAY, FEBRUARY 17, 2019

Chairperson Zuleger called the meeting to order at 3:30 p.m.

Zuleger read a statement regarding the posting of the meeting.

Present: Brenda Staszak, Kay Zuleger and Tim Kelley. Also, present, Michelle Maroszek, Clerk; Robbie Woldt, Fire Chief. Excused: Eric Krause, Police Chief.

AGENDA: Motion by Staszak, second by Kelley, to approve agenda as presented and to deviate from the order as necessary. Motion carried unanimously.

MINUTES. Motion by Zuleger, second by Kelley, to approve minutes from January 20, 2020, Public Safety Committee meeting as presented. Motion carried unanimously.

Fire Chief: One of the Fire trucks froze up during the cold weather, working on fixing the problem. Firefighters will be going on a tour of Pierce on Tuesday, February 18.

G3. Closed Session. Motion by Staszak, second by Kelley, to move to closed session for approximately five minutes for the purpose of interviewing candidate for part-time officer position. Inviting Clerk Maroszek to attend. [Pursuant to Wis. State Statutes, Chapter 19, General Duties of Public Officials, subchapter V, 19.85 exemptions (1)(c) Considering employment, promotion, compensation or performance evaluation data of any public employee over which the governmental body has jurisdiction or exercises responsibility.] Roll call vote was taken. Motion carried unanimously. Committee moved to closed session at 3:35 p.m.

*Motion by Staszak, second by Kelley, to recommend to the Board to hire Drake Feriancek as a part-time police officer. Motion carried unanimously.*

Motion by Kelley, second by Staszak, to return to open session. Roll call vote was taken. Motion carried unanimously. Committee returned to open session at 3:54 p.m.

G1. Part-time Police Officer Pay Scale and Probationary Status Policy. Motion by Zuleger, second by Kelley, to recommend to the board the proposed part-time police officer pay scale and probationary status policy. Motion carried unanimously.

G2. Update Village Bond Schedule. The bond schedule for the Village needs to be updated to remove fees for skateboards and inline skates, and to add new fees for ATV/UTV ordinance. Motion by Zuleger, second by Staszak, to recommend to the Board to amend the Village Bond

Schedule removing fees for the skateboards and inline skate ordinances and to add fees for the ATV/UTV ordinance with direction from Chief Krause on fees. Motion carried unanimously.

H1. Negotiating Municipal Court Fees. By consensus the committee agreed to bring item back for the April meeting.

Next meeting: Tentatively, Monday, March 16 at 3:30 p.m., if there are items to discuss. Otherwise, will meet on Monday, April 20, at 3:30 p.m.

Motion by Kelley, second by Staszak, to adjourn. Motion carried unanimously. Meeting adjourned at 4:04 p.m.
