Chairperson Zuleger announced meeting at 3:30 p.m. and read a statement regarding the posting of the meeting.

Present: Kay Zuleger, Brenda Staszak, Tim Kelley. Police Chief Eric Krause and Fire Chief Robbie Woldt were also present.

AGENDA: Motion by Kelley, second by Staszak, to approve agenda as presented and deviate from the order as necessary. Motion carried.

MINUTES. Motion by Kelley, second by Zuleger, to approve the minutes from the April 27, 2020 meeting. Motion carried.

Fire Chief gave report. Firefighter response is down. Fire Inspections will now resume. The new firetruck is expected to be ready at the end of December.

Police Chief: Calls are getting busier; traffic is picking up. Shawano County released a report and it showed the Village of Bonduel had the 3<sup>rd</sup> highest call volume in 2019, with over 900 calls.

Motion by Kelley, second by Staszak, to recommend to the board that the application is approved. Motion carried

(b) applies which, if discussed in public, would have a substantial adverse effect on the reputation of any person referred to in such histories or data, or involved in such problems or investigation.] At the end of the Closed Session, the Committee will reconvene to Open Session.**

Motion by Kelley, second by Staszak, to go into closed session at 3:50 p.m. for approximately five minutes inviting Chief Eric Krause and Deputy Clerk Katrina Schroeder. Motion carried, roll call vote taken.

Motion by Staszak, second by Zuleger, to come out of closed session at 4:18 p.m. Motion carried, roll call vote taken, unanimous.

**G3 & G4 Discussion and possible recommendation on 2020-2021 Liquor License applications and Discussion and possible recommendation on 2020-2021 Operator's License applications.**

Motion by Staszak, second by Kelley to recommend to approve all Liquor and Operator's licenses for 2020-2021 to the Village Board with the conditional use letters compiled by Chief Krause for any individual with a violation. Motion carried
