

VILLAGE OF BONDUEL
PUBLIC SAFETY COMMITTEE MEETING
WEDNESDAY, JANUARY 27, 2021

Chairperson Zuleger called the meeting to order at 3:30 p.m.

Zuleger read a statement regarding the posting of the meeting.

Present: Brenda Staszak, Kay Zuleger. Tim Kelley was absent. Also, present, Katrina Thorne, Deputy Clerk; Police Chief Eric Krause, Fire Chief Robbie Woldt and DMO Jesse Rankin.

AGENDA: Motion by Staszak, second by Zuleger, to approve agenda as presented and deviate as necessary. Motion carried unanimously.

MINUTES. Motion by Staszak, second by Zuleger, to approve minutes from October 26, 2020 Public Safety Committee meeting. Motion carried.

Fire Chief Report The old fire truck will be picked up on 1/30/2021

Police Chief Report. Officer Feriancek was hired full time in Shawano but will stay on at Bonduel part time. Municipal Court fees should be looked at as it seems it isn't economical right now for the Village. Chief Krause will draft a letter to municipal court for the committee to review at the next Public Safety meeting.

G1: Discussion and possible recommendation on parking concerns on Sunshine and Jefferson Streets

Apartment building owner had a tenant request that 15 minute parking signs be installed in front of building for tenants to unload items. Tenant no longer lives in the building at the time of this meeting. Committee along with DMO and Police Chief discussed that there was adequate parking behind the building in the parking lot. Motion by Zuleger, second by Staszak, to not approve the request. Motion carried.

G1: Discussion and possible recommendation on 106 Jefferson address

Emergency personnel has some trouble with the address for emergency calls. Better signage on building would help. Motion by Staszak, second by Zuleger, to have DMO Ranking talk to building owner to put the proper signage on property. Motion carried.

G3: Discussion and possible action on part-time police officers

Chief Krause requests that he is allowed to put together an eligibility list for future hires in case any current p/t officers would leave and the Village would save time on the hiring process.

Motion by Staszak, second by Zuleger, to have Chief Krause compile an eligibility list for future hiring. Motion carried.

G4: Discussion and possible recommendation on video storage system

Police department video equipment currently doesn't have the capability to blur out people if they aren't involved with the incident. The police department will be switching to an amazon.gov account which will allow blurring on those not involved in the incident. Discussion only.
