

VILLAGE OF BONDUEL  
PUBLIC SAFETY COMMITTEE MEETING  
WEDNESDAY, APRIL 21, 2021

Chairperson Zuleger called the meeting to order at 12:00 p.m.

Zuleger read a statement regarding the posting of the meeting.

Present: Kay Zuleger, Tim Kelley and Brenda Staszak. Also, present, Michelle Maroszek, Clerk and Eric Krause, Police Chief.

AGENDA: Motion by Staszak, second by Kelley, to approve agenda as presented and to deviate from the order as necessary. Motion carried unanimously.

MINUTES. Motion by Kelley, second by Zuleger, to approve the minutes from February 15, 2021 Public Safety Committee meeting with noted correction. Motion carried Unanimously.

Police Chief Report. There were a few officers on this past weekend to cover the prom, all went well no issues. There will be a medication collection this weekend at the police station. The department is working on setting up a drive through and drop box for the collection to minimize personal contact.

G1: Part-Time Officer Applications. Krause reported there were over 40 applications submitted for the part-time officer posting. He has narrowed it down to 20 qualified applicants. Krause is looking for direction from the committee on how they would like to proceed. At this point, the department is looking to create a list of potential candidates to pull from when ready to hire. Krause would like to have current police officers do initial interviews to narrow the list down further. That list would then be presented to Public Safety to interview. Motion by Kelley, second by Staszak, to allow Chief Krause and other department officers to conduct pre-interviews of candidates in order to narrow down list to present to Public Safety for consideration. Motion carried unanimously.

G2. Appeal for Village Sex Offender Residency Restrictions Ordinance Sec. 22-21. Robert Schlender is a lifetime sex offender registrant. Currently, his wife resides in the Village of Bonduel and Robert has an apartment in Shawano. Schlender is asking to appeal the Village ordinance on residency restrictions, in order to move in with his wife in Bonduel. Schlender is 90 years old and has multiple health issues which are requiring more assistance. Schlender is no longer on probation and has no parole agent. Krause has dropped off the sex offender residency appeal application for Schlender to fill out. By consensus the committee agreed to move the agenda item to the next meeting when the filled-out application can be reviewed.

H1. Municipal Court fee negotiation. Krause sent out letters to all that are involved with the Municipal Court fees on March 31, 2021. There has been no response from anyone at this time. The meeting to address the fees is scheduled for Monday, May 24<sup>th</sup> at 3:30 p.m. By consensus the committee agreed to move the agenda item to the next meeting to negotiate municipal court fees.
