Police Chief Report. 1400 calls so far this year. Suppressors were bought to make assault rifles quieter for ear safety. Crown Vic got towed, is getting repaired.

G1: Discussion and possible recommendation on semi-truck parking on streets

Police Chief was approached by residents asking for restrictions on semi-truck parking. Committee decided to not take any action on this item as they feel it isn't needed. Motion by Kelley, second by Staszak to not take any action.

G2: Discussion and possible recommendation on Public Safety 2022 budget

Chief Robbie Woldt is hoping to get a grant to buy a washing machine next year for turnout gear. Chief Eric Krause would like to hire a clerk to enter data for an average of 8 hours a week. Budget for this position would be around \$5500.00/year.
