PUBLIC SAFETY COMMITTEE MEETING

Email sent from Village insurance in regards to their stance on ride alongs was dispersed. Committee asked for a copy of the waiver be sent to the insurance to see if it covers what they may be looking for. Police Department Policy book is currently being typed and updated by Chief Krause since the most recent one from 2011 is only a hard copy and has not been updated for 10 years. Once Chief Krause has this completed, he will present to the committee. No action taken, remove item by consensus.

G2: Closed session. Move to closed session to discuss annual employee reviews and salaries as it relates to the 2022 Budget. [Pursuant to Wis. State Statutes, Chapter 19, General Duties of Public Officials, subchapter V, 19.85 exemptions (1)(c): Considering employment, promotion, compensation or performance evaluation data of any public employee over which the governmental body has jurisdiction or exercises responsibility.] At the end of the closed session, the Committee will reconvene to open session.

Motion by Staszak, second by Zuleger to go into closed session for approximately 5 minutes at 12:19 p.m. inviting in Chief Krause and Deputy Clerk Katrina Thorne. Roll call vote taken, motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Kelley, second by Staszak to come out of closed session at 1:37 p.m. Roll call vote taken, motion carried unanimously
