

VILLAGE OF BONDUEL  
PUBLIC SAFETY COMMITTEE MEETING  
WEDNESDAY, MAY 18 2022

Chairperson Zuleger called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m.

Zuleger read a statement regarding the posting of the meeting.

Present: Kay Zuleger, Tim Kelley and Brenda Staszak. Also, present, Eric Krause, Police Chief and Robbie Woldt, Fire Chief.

AGENDA: Motion by Kelley, second by Staszak, to approve agenda as presented. Motion carried unanimously.

MINUTES: Motion by Kelley, second by Zuleger, to approve the minutes from the April 6, 2022, Public Safety Meeting as presented. Motion carried unanimously.

Fire Chief Report: The Fire Department will be applying for the DNR grant which is a 50/50 wildland gear grant.

Police Chief Report. The department received 24 applications for the part-time officer position. Chief Krause and Officer Hoffman will be interviewing ten of the applicants on June 20<sup>th</sup>, and will get it down to three applicants to bring to the Committee to interview.

NEW BUSINESS

G1: Discussion and possible recommendation on 2022-2023 Liquor License applications. All Liquor Licenses have been received except for Dollar General. Maroszek has spoken with Dollar General Corporate office and the application should be coming by the end of the month. The Lumberyard license is approved with a conditional letter of agreement. Motion by Staszak, second by Kelley to recommend to the Board to approve all Liquor Licenses as presented, including the Lumberyard with the conditional letter of agreement. In addition, the Board will need to review the Dollar General Liquor License at the Board meeting when that comes in. Motion carried unanimously.

G2: Discussion and possible recommendation on 4<sup>th</sup> of July Celebration. Chief Krause asked the Committee about their thoughts on safety for the parade due to the incident that took place this past winter in Waukesha. The Committee felt that what has been done in the past is sufficient for barricades and safety. Krause reported that there will be police staffing all day for the fourth, including assistance from the State Troopers. Fire Chief Woldt stated that the Fire Department will be available to help with signage and during the parade. The plan is to have town shut down by 10:45 a.m. with the parade start time at 11:00 a.m. Chief Krause will be attending the Celebrate Bonduel planning meeting on Monday, May 23<sup>rd</sup>. By consensus the Committee agreed to remove the item from the agenda.

G3: Discussion and review of Bonduel Municipal Code Sec. 2-83, Ethical Standards and Regulations. Zuleger reminded the Committee that the Village ethical standards and regulations are reviewed each year. Committee reviewed ordinance and did not have any questions.

G4: Discussion and possible action on selection of Public Safety Committee meeting date and time. At this time, it was not feasible to set a exact date and time to meet. By consensus the Committee agreed to continue to meet as needed and to schedule meetings according to Chief Krause's work schedule.

#### UNFINISHED BUSINESS

H1: Discussion and possible recommendation on False Alarm Ordinance. The Committee reviewed the sample false alarm ordinance provided. This ordinance was more what the committee wanted to see for the Village. Changes were made to have the penalties be in place for a 12-month period versus a calendar year and to change the forfeiture amount to \$500 max plus court fees. Motion by Kelley, second by Staszak, to recommend to the Board the creation of the false alarm ordinance and update the Village Bond schedule to include the new ordinance and penalties. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Zuleger, second by Kelley, to adjourn at 6:31 p.m. Motion carried unanimously.
