THE VILLAGE BOARD OF THE VILLAGE OF BONDUEL, SHAWANO COUNTY, WISCONSIN, DO ORDAIN that CHAPTER 8, COURTS, §8-3 – Municipal court judge, (b) Election, term, is hereby repealed and recreated to read as follows:

Sec. 8-3. Municipal court judge.

(b) Election, term. At the spring election in even-numbered years, commencing in 2016, the municipal judge shall be elected at large by the electors of the city and the village for a term of four years, commencing on May 1, succeeding the election. The municipal judge shall serve until a successor is elected and qualified. Mid-term vacancies in the office of Municipal Judge shall be filled by appointment, as agreed upon by the city council and village board, pursuant to Wis. Stats. Section 8.50(4)(fm).

This Ordinance shall take effect upon passage and posting as provided by law.
