**THE VILLAGE BOARD OF THE VILLAGE OF BONDUEL, SHAWANO COUNTY, WISCONSIN, DO ORDAIN that the Municipal Code of Bonduel, Wisconsin, CHAPTER 22, Orderly Conduct, §22-21 – Sexual Offender Residency Restrictions, (g) Appeal,** is hereby amended to read as follows:

**Sec. 22-21. Sexual Offender Residency Restrictions.**

(g) *Appeal.* The above requirements may be waived or modified with the approval of the Village Board upon appeal by the affected party under the provisions hereof:

- (1) Procedure. An appellant shall prepare and file with the Village Clerk an official Residency Appeal Form, on forms provided by that office. The Village Board shall schedule and hold a hearing on the Appeal during which hearing the Village Board shall receive reports from the Police Department and may review any pertinent information and may accept sworn oral testimony or written statements from any interested persons.
- (2) Notice. Notice of the hearing shall be published as a Class 1 Notice under the provisions of Sec. 987.07(1), Wis. Stats.
- (3) Decision. Following testimony, the Village Board shall base its decision on whether the offender has shown remorse, has rehabilitated, could re-offend, and any other factors related to the Village's interest in promoting, protecting, and improving the health, safety and welfare of the community. The decision shall be by majority vote of the Board. The decision to grant residency may be unconditional or may be subject to such reasonable conditions as the evidence presented shall, in the opinion of the Village Board, so warrant. The Board's decision shall be final. The decision shall be in writing and provided to the appellant.
- (4) Special Meeting. If an applicant requests a special Village board meeting, said applicant shall pay the required fee as listed on the fee schedule before meeting is approved and posted.

This Ordinance shall take effect upon passage and posting as provided by law.
