**THE VILLAGE BOARD OF THE VILLAGE OF BONDUEL, SHAWANO COUNTY, WISCONSIN, DO ORDAIN that the Municipal Code of Bonduel, Wisconsin, Chapter 16 HEALTH AND SANITATION, Article III., Section 16-50 Garbage and Recyclables** is hereby repealed and recreated as follows:

Sec. 16-50. - Garbage and recyclables.

(a) *Garbage placement and pickup.*

(1) Cart Placement

- a. Carts should be placed no more than three (3) feet from curb.
- b. There needs to be at least three (3) feet between your cart and any other objects such as parked cars, light poles, mailboxes and other carts.
- c. Cart handle should be facing the house and away from the street.

(2) Garbage shall be placed on the curb by the designated time listed in schedule of fees and services.

(3) The following items shall not be picked up:

- a. Yard waste.
- b. Auto batteries.
- c. Furniture and appliances.
- d. Tires.
- e. Household hazardous wastes.

(b) *Recyclables placement and pickup.*

(1) Cart Placement

- a. Carts should be placed no more than three (3) feet from curb.
- b. There needs to be at least three (3) feet between your cart and any other objects such as parked cars, light poles, mailboxes and other carts.
- c. Cart handle should be facing the house and away from the street.

d. Acceptable items for recycling include Plastics #1-#7 (bottles, jugs and jars only) corrugated cardboard flattened, glass bottles and jars, metal and aluminum cans, newspaper and magazines.

(2) Recyclables shall be placed at the curb for collection by the designated time as listed on the schedule of fees and services.

*(c) Use of recycling center.*

(1) The following items may be brought to the recycling center by village residents during recycling center hours:

- a. Yard waste.
- b. Waste oil.
- c. Auto batteries.
- d. Furniture and appliances.
- e. Small amounts of construction waste, as determined by the director of municipal operations.

(2) The following items shall not be accepted:

- a. Tires.
- b. Large amounts of construction waste, as determined by the director of municipal operations.
- c. Hazardous materials.

*(d) Recycling hours.* As listed in the schedule of fees and services.

This ordinance shall take effect upon passage and publication and/or posting as provided by law.
