**THE VILLAGE BOARD OF THE VILLAGE OF BONDUEL, SHAWANO COUNTY, WISCONSIN, DO ORDAIN that CHAPTER 26, Streets, Sidewalks, and Other Public Places, §26-9, DRIVEWAYS,** is hereby repealed and recreated as follows:

**Sec. 26-9. – Driveways.**

- (a) *Permit required.* No person shall construct any new driveway across any sidewalk or curbing without first obtaining a driveway permit from the director of municipal operations. The applicant for a driveway permit shall file the application with the director and furnish a drawing designating his property lines, the location and width of the proposed driveway and the location of any driveway and street intersection within 150 feet of the proposed driveway.
- (b) *Permit fee.* The permit fee is listed in the schedule of fees and services.
- (c) *Number of Driveways.* Only one driveway shall be permitted for a residential lot. A typical commercial and industrial property shall be allowed a maximum of two driveways, located at least 50 ft apart. Additional driveways maybe permitted for residential, commercial and industrial lot with written justification of the need and approval from the Municipal Operations Committee. The minimum distance between a driveway and nearest public road or street shall be 50ft.
- (d) *Culverts required.* The village shall determine if a culvert shall be required in conjunction with any driveway construction. The property owner shall be responsible for the cost of the culvert and installation. The design of the driveway shall be in accordance with the schedule of policies and standards. The means and methods of driveway construction shall be as provided in the standard specifications.

This Ordinance shall take effect upon passage and posting as provided by law.
