THE VILLAGE BOARD OF THE VILLAGE OF BONDUEL, SHAWANO COUNTY, WISCONSIN, DO ORDAIN that CHAPTER 22, Orderly Conduct, §22-2, THROWING OR SHOOTING OF ARROWS, STONES AND OTHER MISSILES PROHIBITED, is hereby repealed and recreated as follows:

Sec. 22-3. – Throwing or shooting of arrows, stones and other missiles prohibited.

- (a) No person shall throw or shoot any object, arrow, stone, snowball or other missile or projectile by hand or by any other means at any person or at, in or into any building, street, sidewalk, alley, highway, park, playground or other public place within the village.
- (b) A person shall be allowed to bow hunt pursuant to the provisions of Wisconsin Law, except that a person shall not hunt with a bow and arrow or a crossbow within 100 yards from a building located on another person's land. This restriction shall not apply if a person who owns the land on which the building is located allows the hunter to hunt within said 100 yards of the building. In addition, a person who hunts with a bow and arrow or a crossbow shall only discharge the arrow or bolt from the respective weapon toward the ground. Wis. Stats. § 29.038(3)(a)(b).

This Ordinance shall take effect upon passage and posting as provided by law.
