**THE VILLAGE BOARD OF THE VILLAGE OF BONDUEL, SHAWANO COUNTY, WISCONSIN, DO ORDAIN THAT THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF BONDUEL, WISCONSIN, CHAPTER 115, ZONING CODE, §115-16, PUBLIC DISTRICT, (2) CONDITIONAL USES (aa) is hereby amended as follows:**

**Sec. 115-16. – PUBLIC DISTRICT**

(2) *Conditional uses.*

- a. Boat launching areas.
- b. Bridle paths and hiking trails.
- c. Public campgrounds and recreational camps. Prior to granting a conditional use permit for the development or improvement of a campground, the village board, after review by the plan commission, shall make the following determinations:
  1. The maximum number of campsites shall be 15 per acre.
  2. Minimum dimensions of a campsite shall be 25 feet wide by 40 feet long.
  3. Each campsite must be separated from other campsites by a yard not less than 15 feet.
  4. There shall be a minimum of 1 automobile parking space for each campsite.
  5. There shall be a minimum yard setback of 40 feet from all exterior lot lines of the campground.
  6. It shall conform to the requirement of the Wisconsin Administrative Code which shall apply until amended and then apply as amended.
- d. Cemeteries.
- e. Churches, synagogues and temples.
- f. College dormitories.
- g. Correctional and rehabilitation facilities exempt from the provisions of Wis. Stats. 301.16(3).
- h. Crop farming, forestry and open space.

- i. Dog parks.
- j. Forest and indigenous game reserves.
- k. Golf courses and country clubs.
- l. Sportsmen club meeting facilities, no outdoor firearm discharge.
- m. Nursery schools.
- n. Orphanages.
- o. Private elementary and high schools.
- p. Private parks.
- q. Rectories, convents and monasteries.
- r. Riding academies.
- s. Riding stables.
- t. Roadside stands for farm produce.
- u. Sale of bait and sporting goods and supplies, excluding camping trailers and tents.
- v. Indoor skeet, trap and shooting ranges.
- w. Transportation, utility, communication, or other uses that is not required under state or federal law.
- x. Universities and colleges.
- y. Transportation, utility, communication, or other uses that are not required under state or federal law.
- z. Stormwater management facilities.
- aa. Agricultural uses. Within the context of agricultural uses, animal units mean domestic animals traditionally used in this state in the production of food, fiber or other animal products. Including cattle, swine, poultry, sheep, goats, equine animals, bison, farm-raised deer, fish, captive game birds, rabbits, camelids or mink. Beekeeping, grazing, field crops, forestry, green houses (private use), orchards, tree and shrub nurseries, mushrooms, wild crop harvesting and other horticultural activities that provide on-site sales of raw products.

This Ordinance shall take effect upon passage and posting as provided by law.
