Operator license background investigation policy

All applicants will undergo a background investigation to help insure the reliable, safe and responsible serving of malt liquors and intoxicating beverages by individuals employed to do so. All applicants must be of fair character and free from felony and recent criminal convictions. Backgrounds will be conducted in accordance with WI State Statute 125.04(5).

The application must be filled out thoroughly and honestly. If any violations are omitted, it will be considered a false application, resulting in the delay and/or possible denial of the application.

The following is a list of standards that will be used to “evaluate” an application based on previous convictions. Cases that are pending will not disqualify applicants although the outcome may revoke an issued license at the time of conviction.

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|---------------------------------------------------------------------|--------|
| 1) Operate While Intoxicated 1 st Offense (Past 3 Years) | 6 pts. |
| 2) Operate While Suspended (Past 3 Years) | 4 pts. |
| 3) Negative Police Contact (No Conviction Needed) (Past 3 Years) | 6 pts. |

Disqualifiers:

- 1) Any Felony Conviction-Lifetime
- 2) Any criminal, ordinance or traffic conviction involving alcohol as follows:
 - 1 conviction in past 3 years
 - 2 convictions in past 10 years
 - 3 convictions in a lifetime
- 3) Any previous operator violations within last 10 years.
- 4) Any criminal conviction as follows:
 - 1 conviction in past 3 year
 - 2 convictions in past 10 years
 - 3 convictions in lifetime
- 5) Any drug possession or drug paraphernalia conviction last 10 years.
- 6) Any drug distribution or multiple drug possession convictions- lifetime.

The following point system will be used to “evaluate” a background. If 12 points are incurred or accumulated at any time in one year, the license will be denied. If a license is issued, with or without points, and 12 points are accumulated throughout the year, the license will be revoked. The preceding is not conclusive. The Bonduel Police Department reserves the right of recommendation of approval or denial of the operator license. In the case of a denial, the application will be recommended to the Village Board to review the application for final determination and appeal. Recommendation will be based on information provided by whatever means necessary by law. Reasons for denial will be given by request only.
