| Water Penalty | A penalty of 1% per month is charged for any past due |

| Sewer Penalty | A penalty of 1% per month is charged for any past due |

The Public Service Commission of Wisconsin determines all water rates, penalty, and the fire protection fee. The Village Board determines all sewer and refuse rates.

Utility Bills

The Bonduel Sewer and Water Utility issue bills on a monthly basis. Bills are mailed on the last business day of the month. They are due the 20th of each month (this is determined by the Public Service Commission of Wisconsin).

Disconnect or delinquent notices are mailed the 25th of each month. If the 25th falls on a weekend, the notices are mailed that following Monday. Per the Public Service Commission, the customer has 10 days in which to pay the delinquency or to arrange for payment. Any delinquent account is subject to shut off for non-payment.
